

Sacred Heart Middle School Dance Rules as of August 25, 2011

- All students must abide by the dress code posted for the event.
- Only current SH Middle school students are permitted to attend dances. Sacred Heart students caught trying to sneak in non-SH students will also be asked to leave.
- All students may have their photos taken by professional photographer on site. There is no obligation to purchase the photos.
- Students may enjoy snacks and beverages ONLY in assigned food court area.
- The use of cell phones and personal music devices are prohibited during the dance. Students may take five minutes to contact parents to inform them of this rule. If students are caught using cell phones or iPods without consent, they will be confiscated until the event is concluded.
- Be respectful of your peers, chaperones and the facility.
- No verbal and/or physical violence will be tolerated.
- All students are required to remain inside the gym for the duration of the dance as a safety precaution until a parent or guardian comes to take them home.
- No guarantees will be given that requested music will be played.
- If someone of the opposite gender asks you to dance, your considerate answer should be “yes”. You are not required to dance with the same person more than once during the evening.
- No grinding, moshing, freaking, slamming or any other kind of inappropriate dancing will be permitted.
- Crying must be kept to a minimum, preferably not at all.
- Follow the directions of the chaperones when asked to do something.
- Dance ends at 10 p.m. unless another time is stated.
- Show your appreciation to our DJ and the chaperones because without them there would not be a dance.
