

Rules for Jr. High Dances sponsored by the Sacred Heart Youth Ministry
Office.

All participants must abide by the dress code posted for the event.

All participants may have their photos taken by photographer on site.
There is no obligation to purchase the photos.

All participants may enjoy snacks and beverages only in the assigned food
court area.

The use of cell phones and personal music devices are not permitted during
the dance. Participants may take 5 minutes to contact parents to inform
them of this rule. After that time, use of phones will be confiscated until
the dance is over.

All participants are to respect each other and all Sacred Heart facilities.

All participants are required to remain inside the gym for the duration of
the dance or until a parent/guardian comes to take them home.

No damage is to be done to any bathroom or any piece of property.

No guarantees will be given that requested music will be played.

If someone of the opposite gender asks you to dance, your answer is to be
“yes”. You are not required to dance with the same person more than once
during the evening.

These types of dancing are not permitted...mosh, slam, body surfing,
grinding.

Crying must be kept to a minimum, preferably not at all.

Follow the directions of the chaperones when asked to do something

Dance ends at 10 PM unless another time is stated.
