Hearing screenings are often administered to children during their preschool and school age years. Screenings are designed to be a “quick look” at the child’s hearing skill. Results of the screenings are reported as a “Pass” indicating no further assessment recommended or “Refer” meaning further assessment is recommended. The “Refer” **does not mean** a problem exists; it means further assessment is recommended.

A speech-language pathology clinical faculty member and team of graduate students from The University of TN Hearing and Speech Center will provide screenings free of charge on October 15, 2024. They will screen children attending grades 1st, 3rd, 5th, and 7th.
