12:55-1:05 - Drumline + cheerleaders do crowd involvement cheer

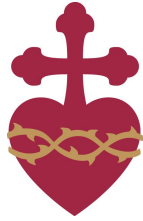
1:05-1:15 - Announce boys basketball players + GOTCHA

Dress: Uniform bottoms with orange and white or UT apparel

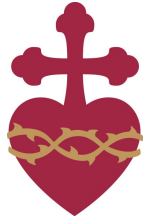
Events:

2:00-2:20 - First Friday Benediction (whole school)

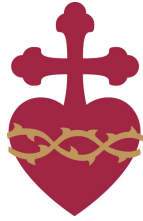
